


## Canterbury Court




# Simple Private Spaces
















#### Furniture Plan

The theater and the gaming room have acoustic panels to reduce sound and to not disturb residents in nearby rooms.




#### Rest

There are several places along the corridors where residents can take a break and rest as needed before heading on their way.


#### **.....** Wide Corridors

#### Theory Application


Biomimicry studies systems and patterns found in nature to create a better design. The 3 essential elements of biomimicry are:
